JUDGING FACTORS INTERPRETATION: Musical feeling that is in good taste and includes tonal balance, phrasing, tempo, expression and artistry.
TONE and INTONATION: Beauty of tone quality and correctness of pitch, playing in tune.
ENSEMBLE WORK: Togetherness factors—starting/stopping, tempi, phrasing, dynamics, etc.
TECHNIQUE : Correct and proper tonguing, articulation, support, fingering and other performance procedures.
LITERATURE : Quality of literature should be representative of age and musical maturity of students.
