SJMEA Fall Meeting - Sept. 2, 2015

Meeting called to order by President, Steve Menefee (Ferndale High School Bands) at 6:33. Steve brought food and water for everyone. Introductions followed by everyone present.

Steve brought the following to us from WMEA.

- 1. Legislative change to include Music as a core subject in National Language.
- 2. Yakima Conference will be Feb. 12 14.
- 3. Awards for Music Educator of the Year and Friend of Music.
 - a. Please send your suggestions to Steve by the end of September!
- 4. Music Matters License Plates support our programs in addition to State programs.
- 5. Voice Magazine is the publication that comes out from the State about Music Education.
 - a. Regional News in that publication needs information from us so we can publish what we are doing in our programs. Please send Steve your information.

Linda Short, Secretary, (Choir Director at Bellingham HS and Whatcom and Kulshan Middle Schools) drew attention to the minutes from last spring which were available in print form. She also mentioned that the communications position could be consolidated with the secretary job for one position. If so, she would be glad to relinquish the secretary position. Steve said we would talk about that later at the Executive Board Meeting.

<u>Mitch DeGrace, Treasurer</u>, (Meridian High School Band and Choir Director) talked about a problem with giving stipends to people who are not considered employees. As always Mitch is continuing to deal with this issue with his great attention to detail and very thorough work. Mitch also mentioned the concern about Jr. Honor Festival on-line registration. He suggested that this be discussed at the Junior Break-out session. <u>Some schools still owe money from last year</u>.

Poul Brask, (Sedro Woolley H.S. Choir) asked if the fines mentioned at the Spring Meeting were paid. Mitch said they were not.

Kirstin Doud, (Sehome H.S. Orchestra director led us in applause for Mitch and all the great work he does.

Jessica Schlichting, (Sehome H.S and Fairhaven Middle School Choir Director) asked about a difference listed in the Senior Honor Festival. Mitch explained that the difference was because of the addition of the payment made at the gate compared to those schools who had not paid their correct fees yet.

<u>New Business –</u>

Nancy Sheng, (Lummi School Music) gave a promotion for Whatcom Symphony Orchestra's Music in the Schools program given free to 4 elementary schools during the year.

Chuck Perry, (Ferndale Middle School Bands) asked if the communications position should be listed as an official position for SJMEA. This will also be discussed at the Executive Board Meeting.

Tim Fitzpatrick, (WWU Choral Director) corrected the date for the Men's and Women's Festivals to be held at WWU this year. They are: Women's – Fri., Oct. 30th and Men's - Fri., Feb. 5th

Kirstin Doud pointed out that the dates on the purple sheet were correct (part of the minutes) while the dates on the blue sheet were not so we will follow the purple sheet.

Steve then had us move to our Break-out sessions.

During this discussion, Kevin Allen-Schmid, (Interim Ferndale H.S, Choral Director) volunteered to run the Choral Portion of Senior Honor Festival. At this point, Jacob Scherr, (Mt. Vernon HS Bands) will check into Mt. Vernon and McIntyre Hall, Linda will check into Bellingham High, and since Chris already told us about WWU, Jacob and Linda will give information about their schools to Kirstin and then a decision will be made and sent out to the membership.

Bellingham HS will host Solo/Ensemble on Sat., Jan. 30, 2015

The Jazz Festival will be hosted by Diane Johnson, (Skagit Valley College Choir Director) and coordinated by Poul Brask. The event will be held at McIntyre Hall on Tues., March 1st. Michael Gurele, (Lynden Christian Bands) volunteered to host this event. We will continue as planned in McIntyre and Mt. Vernon High School for this year. Next year, Lynden Christian will host this event.

Jessica Schlichting will help Linda Moore with the running of Senior Large Group Choral Festival this year.

I. Solo/Ensemble – Saturday Feb. 6th, 2016 Kulshan Middle School Bellingham, WA

In the spring, Kyler proposed adding master classes taught by the adjudicators to the schedule. This was well received by those in attendance. J.J. is also going to see about WindWorks offering door prizes such as pencils, folders, reeds, cleaning supplies, etc... for those students who attend a master class in hopes of further enticing students to participate. Penny will work with J.J. to see about scheduling the master class and providing the space for each to occur i.e. staggering master classes in the gym. We thought it would be great if the adjudicator would start each master class by playing an excerpt of their choice for the kids to hear. Ideas

decided at the meeting include:

- 1. Music for master classes Adjudicators will either provide their own music to teach from or teach a concept by rote as determined by what they have been hearing e.g. breath support!
- 2. How many master classes It has been decided we will try two master classes, one in the mid-morning and one in the mid-afternoon, built into the schedule. Please encourage your students to stay and attend.

Couple of reminders: piano solos must be memorized and the school music teacher must register students for Solo/Ensemble, NOT the private teacher.

Band – It was decided we should limit it to 2 bands per school and 15 minute time slots in order for there to be less downtime between groups and in the hopes more schools will stay to listen. Ian would appreciate it if everyone used photocopied scores so he doesn't have to mail originals back to you and alternatively can recycle the photocopies.

Plaques – In the spring, Ian proposed going to banners, like the high school, as they make more of a statement when hung in the music rooms. To cover the costs for banners the fee will increase to \$115 per ensemble.

Lastly, in 2017 Brodniak Hall will be getting renovated, we need someone to step in and host Large Group Band and Choir that year. We are a ways out but be thinking if it would work at your school.
